- Be a participant in the Central Carolina Promise/K14 program, having completed all elements of the New Student Requirements as detailed by CCCC (See https://www.cccc.edu/promise/), some of which are noted below.
- Pursue a focus in the Applied Technologies Program of Study (as listed at https://www.ccc.edu/curriculum/).
- Write an essay of no more than 500 words identifying your career aspirations and explaining why you want to continue your education at CCCC. <u>Include reasons why this scholarship would help you in achieving this goal.</u> Attach the essay to this application.
- Provide a letter of recommendation from a high school teacher, college instructor or non-family member supporting your application for this scholarship.
- Have your high school guidance office provide a certified copy of your transcript as instructed by CCCC.

The Rotary Club of Lillington values academic achievement, community service, and financial need in evaluating this application. We require, if you are selected to receive a scholarship, to:

- Maintain "Good Academic Standing" consistent with CCCC policies.
- Take part in a community service project or school activity.
- Attend at least one meeting of the Rotary Club of Lillington by the end of the calendar year in which awarded and briefly speak to the club about your experience.
- Notify CCCC Student Services by the end of your first semester of your intention to attend for a second semester.
